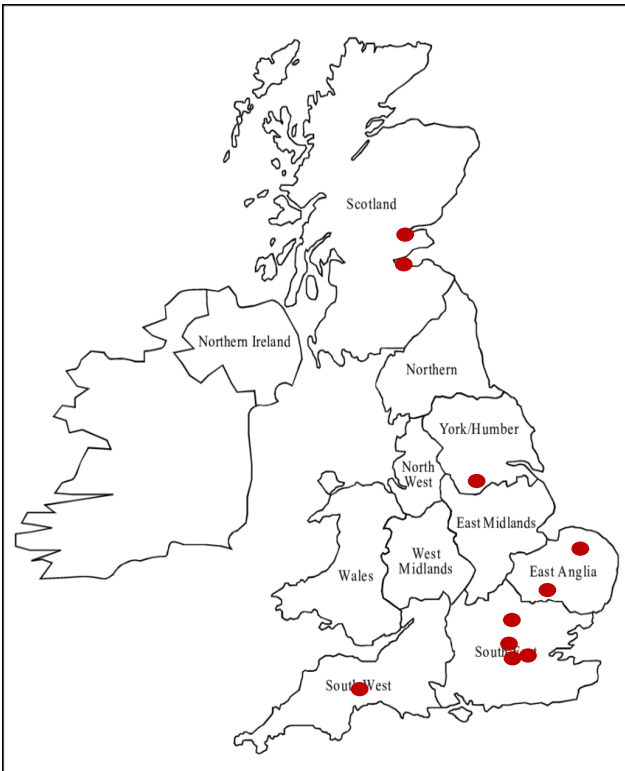


**RECRUITMENT UPDATE**

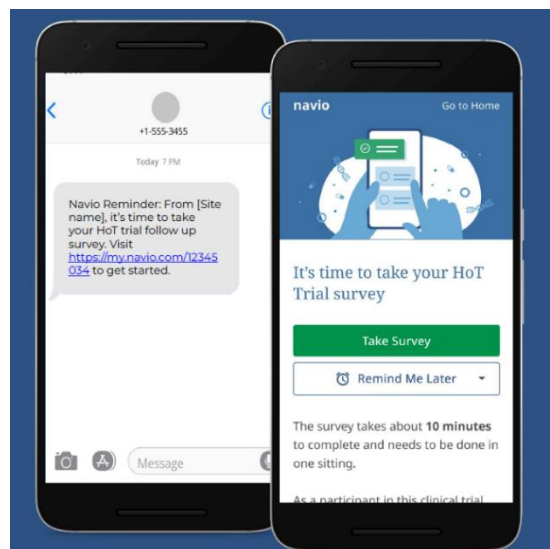

**NAVIO LAUNCH**

We are pleased to share that the NAVIO App is now live for the **HoT** trial!

The NAVIO App will allow patients to take their QoL questionnaires at home in their own time without having to come in to the hospital. As part of an initial pilot phase, the first 30-50 patients who consent to using NAVIO will all complete their trial questionnaires through the app.

NAVIO have emailed site users who have been delegated to task 'M' (NAVIO web-based app registration/updates) on the delegation log directly with a username and password. ## SITE SETUP TIPS

### REGISTERING INTEREST IN THE HOT TRIAL:

If you are interested in participating in the trial we need the following documents in order to proceed:

- Completed Site Registration Form
- Current signed CV & evidence of GCP training for PI & Co-PI (*Note: Co-PI is not mandatory for the trial*)
- Completed Surgical Audit Questionnaire



### PROGRESSING SITE SETUP:

To speed up the set-up process, promptly inform us of:

- **research staff** allocated to complete trial activities as soon as they are identified. This will prevent delays in site set-up communication and scheduling site initiation visit.
- **R&D/set-up contact** so we can send the local information pack and progress contract review.

### After the Site Initiation Visit:

- Sign off the **SIV Report** once we have sent it.
- Complete and send the **SIV attendees log** for everyone present at the SIV.
- Send the completed **delegation log**.
- Staff requiring database/ NAVIO access need to send us an **OpenClinica/ NAVIO Database Access Form** and should be listed on the delegation log and authorised to by PI to perform these tasks.
